

New Care Netram Vision Centre Inaugurated

We inaugurated Care Netram Vision Centre at Johar Hospital -Asha Vihar Bokaro Jharkhand.

Care Netram Vision Centre was inaugurated by **Mr. Hebert Amrein** our partner from **ODG Switzerland**. The Vision Centre aims to increase accessibility & affordability of vision care in the last mile.

Johar Hospital was founded in the year **1995**, about 25 km south of Bokaro Steel City amidst a tribal (Adivasi) region. It occupies 7.5 acres of land, particularly established for the Adivasi people in that region. The WHO-certified non-profit health care organization is operational with 65 workers. It is completely financed by donations.
