Recent studies in India indicate that more than **30% of the blind population** lost their vision before 17 years of age and many lose their sight before 5 years of age. This is majorly due to lack of awareness and **inability of the children to convey their problems** at an early stage.

We are reaching out to as many children as possible to **educate them about good eye health, offer spectacles and provide free eye screening services** as well.



Bridging the **VISION CARE GAP** in **Rural India**

In many low- and middle-income regions of India, access to quality vision care is still scarce, resulting in a rising number of avoidable blindness cases. Care Netram is tackling this challenge by delivering mobile eye care services to rural communities, offering timely eye checkups and affordable eyeglasses to those in need.



EYE-CARE FOR THE SPECIALLY-ABLED

Arfat Sheikh, a 13-year-old boy with a physical disability, is a student at Swami Vivekanand Vidya Mandir School. For some time, he struggled in his studies due to poor vision, making it difficult to see the blackboard and participate in other activities. When he heard about a free eye check-up camp being organized in his village, he attended the event with his father.

After the screening, Arfat discovered that his vision was impaired and he would need glasses. Once he received his new pair of durable, shatterproof glasses, he could finally see clearly again. **With his newfound confidence and improved vision, Arfat can now focus on his studies.** Both he and his father are deeply grateful to Care Netram for helping him see a brighter future.
