# CATARACT IMPACT

We identified patients in need of cataract surgeries during these camps. Through our sponsorship program, we are committed to providing these essential surgeries, ensuring that individuals can regain their sight and improve their quality of life.



In November, Care Netram organized numerous community eye camps in Odisha and Jharkhand, targeting regions with limited access to healthcare. These camps, conducted in collaboration with Vision Care, Nayan Deep, and Trinetramp hospitals, provided free eye check-ups and affordable spectacles to hundreds. For individuals like Dibakar Rout, a bangle seller from Puri, these camps were a lifeline. Dibakar received affordable glasses, allowing him to continue his work with renewed confidence and precision.





# SCHOOL VISION PROGRAMS



A school camp was arranged at **Birikuan village, Keonjhar, on 25 November 2024**, where 51 students and 20 community members received free eye check-ups. Affordable glasses were distributed to those in need, ensuring better vision for both children and adults. This initiative highlights our ongoing efforts to address vision problems early and avoid curable blindness.



# AWARENESS DRIVES

Care Netram conducted group awareness sessions in Kendrapara, educating communities about the importance of timely eye care. These sessions reached hundreds, spreading knowledge about preventing curable blindness and encouraging proactive healthcare measures.

A bangle seller by trade, Renu's deteriorating vision was affecting her livelihood. Unable to afford a hospital visit, she attended a Care Netram camp, where she received glasses that restored her vision. Today, Renu travels confidently between villages, selling her goods and earning her livelihood with pride.





**Suhana Kumari (14, Jamshedpur)**

For months, Suhana struggled to read the blackboard in her classroom. Her vision problem was undiagnosed until Care Netram's school program identified her need for glasses. Now equipped with clear vision, Suhana excels in her studies and dreams of a promising future.



**Mayna Bhuini (55, Dhanbad)**

Mayna, a coal worker, faced challenges in her work due to declining vision. At a Care Netram camp, she received affordable spectacles that transformed her ability to work. Mayna's story is a testament to the impact of accessible eye care on livelihoods.

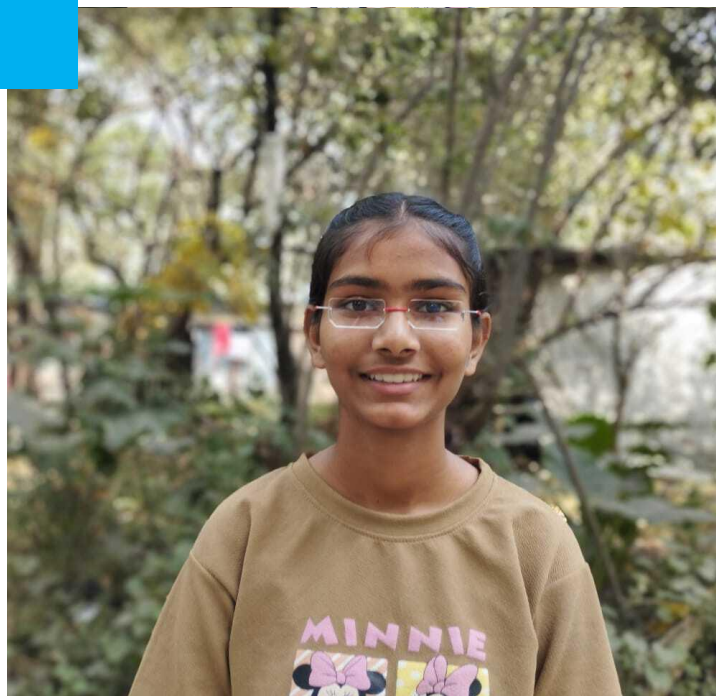
# UPCOMING EVENTS

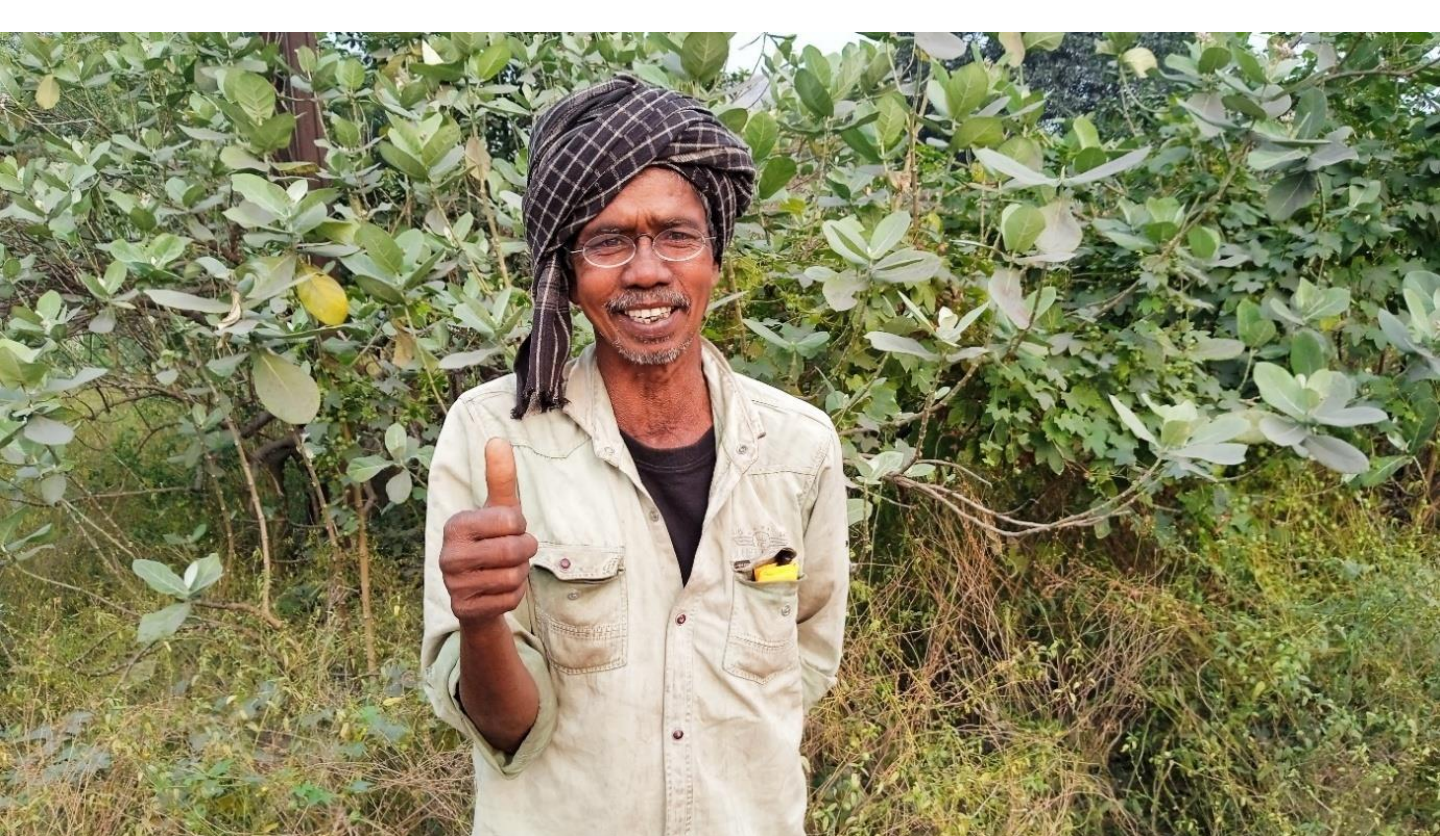
