SCHOOL CAMPS

IGNITING YOUNG MINDS



At Andharikhamana High School in Keonjhar, a dedicated school camp unfolded, transforming the classroom experience for dozens of students. In an environment where blurred writings once hindered learning, our team provided free eye screenings and distributed spectacles that opened new worlds of clarity for young minds.



One student, who had struggled to read the blackboard, now beams with confidence as every word becomes clear. This initiative is more than a medical intervention, it's an investment in the future, empowering children to excel academically and dream big.







On 14 January 2025, Care Netram-GoodVision India Foundation organized a free eye check-up camp at Atri Gram Panchayat. The camp was inaugurated by MLA MR. PRADIPTA along with our dedicated team. A total of 42 individuals were screened; 24 required spectacles, and 23 purchased them at an affordable price. The community expressed heartfelt gratitude for the exceptional service provided by the Care Netram-GoodVision India Foundation team.

Our cataract initiatives have brought renewed hope and dignity to elderly patients across the region. In several eye camps, seniors who had long suffered from cloudy vision were identified and referred for cataract surgeries. One poignant story tells of an elder who, after years of isolation due to vision impairment, now experiences life with clarity and renewed vigour, able to participate in daily activities with confidence.
